



How to Use “Export to SuperGIS Layer File Tool”

This customization tool is used to assist users in converting layer content on ArcMap into the layer format that can be read directly on SuperGIS Desktop. With this tool, the designed map can be transmitted rapidly and displayed on SuperGIS Desktop.

a. On computer installed with Arc Map 9.3:

Enter **C:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework\v2.0.50727\regasm.exe "path to the DLL file" /codebase** as cmd command.

(Please register the dill stored in ArcMXDExportToSLRFile (9.3 version) file.)

b. On computer installed with Arc Map 10.0 or 10.1:

Enter **C:\Program Files\Common Files\ArcGIS\bin\ESRIRegasm.exe "path to the DLL file"** as cmd command and register on Esri register.

(Please register the dill stored in ArcMXDExportToSLRFile (10.0 version) file.)

Finish the registration, you can open ArcMap application and see a tool named “Export to SuperGIS Layer File Tool” within the right-click menu of Main Menu. Subsequently, you can convert layer content on ArcMap into .slr file through clicking button of the tool.
